- Sat 16 March – St Chad's Fullarton, 10am-12 noon

"We are encouraging parishioners from across the Diocese to help make the palm crosses at these workshops – many hands make light work," the Rev'd Paul Devenport, Chair ABM Provincial Committee in South Australia said.
